Introduction, Experimentation on conceptual elements of Architectural Composition: space-limit, light-shadow, atmospheres, matter, time, from abstract to natural contexts, through drawing and 3dmodels.

- 1. To acquire Design thinking and Architectural design skills through tectonic (ex. bamboo) and hypogeum (ex. stone, concrete) typologies.
- 2. To develop professional communication skills through graphical representation, drawings, 3d models, photography, videos, orthogonal projects, critical verbal and written argumentation.
- 3. To use precedence for analysis and comprehension of architectural paradigmatic cases.
- 4. To acquire the basis for the use of structural systems through mono-material compositions: bamboo, wood, stone, bricks, concrete.
- 5. To approach framing elements of an architectural design: site, topography, winds and solar orientation, bioclimatic principles, urban and landscape contexts, framing views, lines of forces.
- 6. To raise awareness about sustainability and ecological footprint of architectural design from project models to building materials.
